Documentation compliance



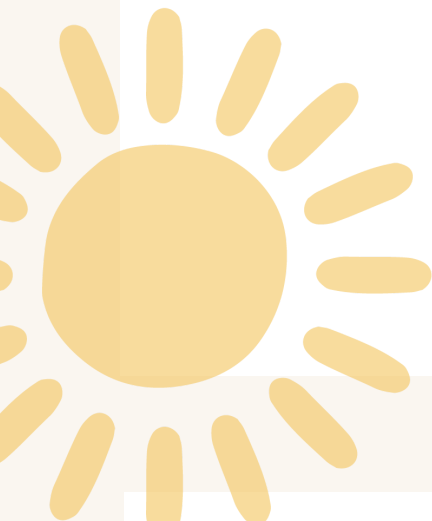
Booking training

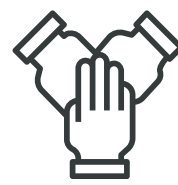
The Portal will mean:

When will it happen?

Moving the data of 99 schools, 9,000 students and 1,500 personnel is going to take some time. And we want to make sure that we do it right!

You might notice some small changes at the start of 2024 - like moving our website. Towards the end of the year in 2024, we will start training school administrators for the new system. By 2025 all schools will be keeping their attendance on The Portal.
